



The 3 Capes site sets the scene for mainly seasonal tourist and leisure activities on land and sea (between the Easter and October holidays, peaking for 2 months in summer). A few traditional and cultural trades exist all year round: vine growing and small fishing businesses.

Seasonal activities affect terrestrial and marine habitats, especially on the site's coastal belt. Monitoring and awareness campaigns take place on land and sea throughout the year to tell visitors how they can help protect the land from the dangers at its door: fire, pollution and climate change.
